Von Willebrand disease

- from theory to clinical practice

An international, case-oriented course for specialists
in internal medicine/haematology

14-16 April 2010, Turning Torso, Malmö, Sweden

The 3-day course will begin with an introduction of VWD through a series of overview lectures. Thereafter, clinical cases will be presented and the management, prognosis, treatment and diagnosis of the disease will be discussed. The course will use an evidence-based approach and participants will review and present scientific articles about VWD.

International guidelines for the management of VWD will be distributed. Participants will receive a course binder including the guidelines, articles and lectures, i.e. "take home messages".

The course is a collaboration between Malmö Centre of Thrombosis and Haemostasis, Lund University, Malmö University Hospital and Octapharma Nordic, Sweden
